### Duties

- Qualifying the voter
- Assisting the voters with the election equipment
- Assist in opening and closing the polling location
- Available to work a minimum of 12 hours on Election Day

### Qualifications

- A resident of Richland County, or an adjoining county
- If age 18 +, you MUST be a qualified registered voter to work on election day
- 16 & 17 year olds may serve as poll managers
- Complete online and in-person training
